KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Ernst FEHR
University of Zurich

Ernst Fehr is a leading scholar in experimental and behavioral economics and Professor of Microeconomics at the University of Zurich. His pioneering work has reshaped the study of social preferences, cooperation, and strategic interactions, integrating insights from psychology and neuroscience to advance the field of neuroeconomics. He has published extensively in top journals and is widely recognized for illuminating the psychological and biological foundations of economic behavior.



Leeat YARIV
Princeton University

Leeat Yariv is the Uwe E. Reinhardt Professor of Economics at Princeton University and the founder of the Princeton Experimental Laboratory for the Social Sciences. Her work spans political economy, market design, networks, and experimental economics. Trained in mathematics, physics, and economics, she is known for influential theoretical and experimental contributions to the study of collective decision-making and social interactions.
